# Thirty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time

## October 31, 2021

### From the Pastor's Desk:

Dear Seton Parish Family,

There is an idea in the Jewish faith that there are the Ten Commandments and then there are many other laws that build a wall around those commandments. These human statutes keep someone from breaking a commandment by placing laws oriented on one's actions making sure they cannot act in a way that would lead them into morally dangerous territory.

Our Gospel today summarizes the Ten Commandments into the Golden rule: Love God with all your heart, soul, and strength and love your neighbor as yourself. This is a beautiful and just way to sum up the Ten Commandments. The first three commandments are concerned firstly with our relationship with God, and the next seven our relationship with others. Most moral stances, and the precepts the Church proposes its members should live, help us understand this Golden Rule. The Precepts of the Church (found in *The Catechism of the Catholic Church* paragraphs 2041-2043) are the minimum ways we try to live out our faith as Catholics. They are concerned primarily with giving God worship and going to the sacraments. The moral ways we are asked to live in this world mostly relate to our relationships with our neighbors and not abusing our freewill to wound others or ourselves.

One final thought about relationships, while I am on the subject, and this is a touchy one: The world loves to proclaim, "Love is love," as if it is a blanket statement and as if love can never be twisted or questioned. The Church has always proclaimed *love in truth*, that love cannot be divorced from truth, or it becomes a feeling- or passion-monster ready to devour everything in sight, like a certain blue monster on Sesame Street devouring cookies.
